ACT

72% of students who took the ACT test as juniors in 2017-18 were proficient in English, 56% in math and 61% in science. The average composite score was 19.6 for GRHS juniors while the state average was 19.4

NWEA Scores

Students who score below 50% proficient are provided with interventions. Scores are reported in grades 4, 8 and 10. In 4th grade 51% of students scored above 50 in reading and 49% in math. In 8th grade 46% in reading and 42% in math. In 10th grade 85% in reading and 81% in math.

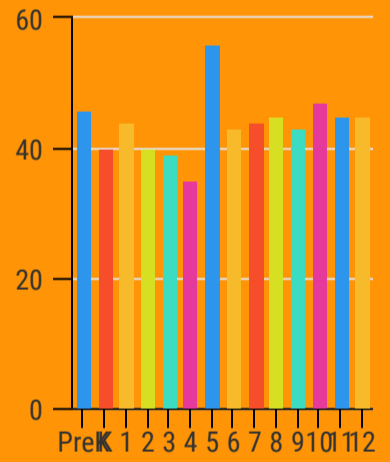

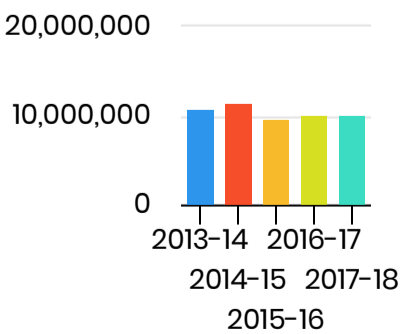

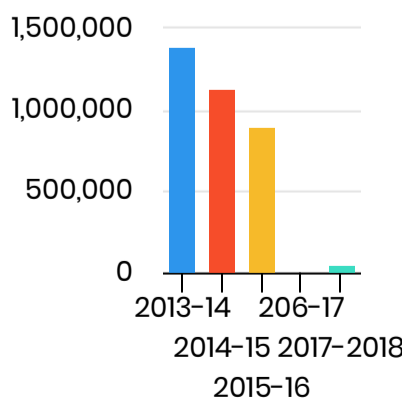
